Full bodied with powerful varietal flavours of bell-pepper, green apple and freshly cut grass. Good structure with lovely balancing acidity.

In the glass, the Spier rosé has a light salmon pink color. In the nose the wine is fragrant, pear and melon, peach, citrus, strawberries, white nectarine and in the mouth the wine is ripe and soft fruity, citrus, good acidity, easy, little sweetness, very mild.

The nose entices with its abundance of ripe plums, blueberries, slight spiciness and notes of violets. Dark berry fruit follows

Intense purple red colour with ruby hues. Aromas of black fruits, jam and vanilla, with a subtle liquorice touch. Sweet and full bodied tannins, with a long and pleasant finish.

Tasting Notes: Ruby. These 2007 merlots from Hawkes Bay are very good. This one is so fragrant there is almost a jujube quality to it, but let's say red roses and red and black plums, with a hint of spice which is almost confusable with ripe syrah. Palate is still firm, good plummy flavours, gentle oak, all in attractive balance and though not a low cropping rate, the wine is more substantial than many from Sileni. 13.5% Vol

Selected from different villages of the Côte d'Or and Côte Châlonnaise. 25% of the blend is matured in oak. This wine reflects the Louis Jadot style - soft as silk and full of plump, ripe, red fruit such as cherries and strawberries.

The Penfolds (BIN)

RO16 The Penfolds Koonunga Hill, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2021, 14.50% Vol

A traditional Australian blend combining the expressiveness of Shiraz with the defined structure of Cabernet Sauvignon. This full-bodied wine shows ripe dark fruit aromas, voluminous richness and plentiful tannins.

RO21 The Penfolds Bin 28 Shiraz, 2021, 14.50%Vol

Bin 28 offers a showcase of warm-climate Australian Shiraz - ripe, robust and generously flavoured. First made in 1959, Bin 28 is named after the famous Barossa Valley Kalimna Vineyard purchased by Penfolds in 1945 and from which the wine was originally sourced.

The Bin 389 Cabernet Shiraz showcases the best of both varietals with its deep crimson colour and aromas of blackberry, cassis and dark chocolate. On the palate, this rich wine is well-balanced with firm tannins and a long, velvety finish. It pairs perfectly with grilled meats or hearty stews.

Our Organic & Biodynamic Wines Selection

Fruit in general and particularly grapes are some of the most pesticide laden products on the planet. As a result, more vineyard owners are reverting to producing organic and biodynamic wines, resulting in healthier, more balanced vineyards after a few years of not damaging the environment by using agro-chemicals.

They also feel that because their wines are so pure, they can also reflect their origins better. Taste the difference and see for yourself!

Organic indicates that the wine has 95% organically grown ingredients (the other 5% must not be available organically). Again the certifying agency must be listed and the wine has the same sulfite requirements as 100% organic.

Biodynamic is based on the precise observation and an attempt at balance of nature, a concept originated by the early 20th-century Austrian philosopher Rudolf Steiner. So, biodynamic wine is not only 100% organic, in addition, the grower has gone beyond to try to bring the farming process more closely in tune with nature. Biodynamic growers may make their own compost and/or carefully watch the stars and phases of the moon.

Zesty, aromatic and lively. Extended lees contact has improved mouth feel and given length on palate.
