Very refined, elegant nose with subtle notes of black fruits. Very round, accessible and fruit, forward on the palate. Well-balanced and racy. Freshness also features.

(65%) Cabernet Sauvignon, (30%) Merlot, (3%) Cabernet Franc and (2%) Petit Verdot aged (50%) new oak, (4%) in terra cotta and (15%) in neutral oak. Tasted three times. (AG) 97+ Inner quote mark (2/2018)
Intense ruby colour. Complex nose of red and black berries, which is well balanced by vanilla and liquor rice notes. After a full attack the elegant tannins reveal all the greatness of their terroir. The delicious palate has a full, powerful structure and good length. The palate aromas confirm the aromatic promise of this wine. A long- 13% Vol
